SAUCER The Auxiliary Control is seen many times in 2 different DISCONNECTION configurations. It is surrounded by the ship's Main Computers **POINTS** which continue here from the center of Deck 7. We also see this area on the U.S.S. CONSTELLATION. FOOD PREPARATION Nurse Christine Chapel entertained children in a "garden". The garden was a new set built for Season 3. There was an intricate planter in the center, shown here in the park. The Water Storage found here is an extension of the Water Storage on Deck 7 as mentioned in TMoST. RECREATION The Food Preparation area has two "conveyors" which ROOM 4 **DECK 8: DORSAL** distribute food upwards into the Messrooms located on Deck 6 and Deck 5. WATER PUMP There are four hatches or ports on the studio model. MACHINERY Two of them are on Deck 8. The other two are on Deck 9. (2 PLACES) Images of these hatches are below, left. Their distribution on GYMNASIUM the studio model is asymmetric, as are the windows around ORGANIC them. The hull is at such an extreme angle that even the STORAGE longest hatch results in an opening only 4 feet (1.2 meters) tall. A crew member in a spacesuit can not fit through any of these SHIP'S hatches. Instead, these 2 hatches probably have a function WATER COMPUTERS similar to the Umbilical Connection Panels as seen on the STORAGE VENTS FOR DISCONNECTION Space Shuttle (below, right). (3 PLACES) LAUNDRY **EQUIPMENT** TMoST states that Material Reclamation and Fabrication is **DECK 8: ENTERTAINMENT / RECREATION FACILITIES** located on this deck. This process is probably not 100% efficient. Therefore, these 2 hatches could allow for transfer of rare elements required in various manufacturing processes.
