

As mentioned on a previous page, there are four hatches or ports on the studio model. Two of them are on Deck 8. The other two are on Deck 9.

Material Reclamation and Fabrication is probably not a 100% efficient process. Therefore, these 2 hatches could allow for transfer of rare elements required in various manufacturing processes.

The remaining space is for Shuttlecraft Maintenance.

A few changes have been made from the original configuration of the Constitution-class ship. Since the number of crew members is lower, the services provided by this deck need not be as extensive.

TMoST mentions Photon Torpedoes but not their location. Photon Torpedoes were shown in various episodes of STAR TREK to emanate from the underside of the Primary Hull, approximately the same place as the Phasers. Since TMoST states Phaser Banks are on Deck 11, the logical spot for Photon Torpedoes and their launch system is on Deck 10. The rest of the deck is filled with Cargo Holds.

Extra Torpedo Launchers have also been installed.

Engineering Monitoring Stations are located here.
The hatch for accessing the Matter-Antimatter Reaction Chamber is located here.


This hatch is usually closed and is heavily shielded.

The disconnection equipment is located here. This area is kept clear and is difficult to enter except by authorized personnel. It is accessible only by ladder.
